In accordance with the Commission's April 18, 2003 release entitled In the Matter of Material to be Filed in Support of 2003 Annual Access Charge Tariff Filings, Tariff Review Plans, DA 03-1176 (2003 TRP Order), the instant filing revises the Company's End User access rates in order to comply with the *Rate-of-Return Access Charge Reform Order*, Multi-Association Group (MAG) Plan for Regulation of Interstate Services of Non-Price Cap Incumbent Local Exchange Carriers and Interexchange Carriers, CC Docket No. 00-256, Second Report and Order and Further Notice of Proposed Rulemaking, 16 FCC Rcd 19613 (2001) (*Rate-of-Return Access Charge Reform Order*). The Company files its End User access rates in accordance with Section 61.38 of the Commission's rules. Cost support material associated with this filing, including the required certification is being submitted in one volume.

Additionally, this filing deletes the Section 17.1 reference to the National Exchange Carrier Association (NECA) Tariff F.C.C. No. 5 Carrier Common Line (CCL) rate reflective of NECA's June 16, 2003 filing to eliminate the CCL rate effective July 1, 2003.
