This application for special permission requests waivers of the requirements of Sections 61.58 and 61.59 of Part 61 of the Commission's Rules in connection with the revision of Southern Kansas Telephone Company's (SKT) Tariff FCC No. 1. SKT believes that a grant of the waivers is in the public interest and requests that the waivers be granted as specified below:

SKT filed tariff revisions in Transmittal No. 14 on June 16, 2003, in accordance with the Annual Filing Requirements, to take effect July 1, 2003. Subsequent to the filing, it was discovered that errors were made. SKT did not properly reallocate their Line Port costs. They applied an amount less than the 30% default allocation. It was also discovered that the 2002 Interstate Revenue Requirements used were incorrect and these amounts were updated to reflect those from the Final 2002 NECA Cost Study. SKT would like to file corrected rate revisions, to take effect on July 1, 2003. Illustrative tariff pages and exhibits supporting the new revisions are attached for your review.

Accordingly, waiver of Section 61.58 is requested to allow these proposed revisions to become effective, on not less than 4 days notice, effective July 1, 2003. A waiver of Section 61.59 is also requested to permit revisions to tariff material that has not yet become effective.

The original letter of application, along with FCC Form 159 and filing fees in the amount \$695, is concurrently being delivered to the Lockbox Shift Supervisor-Mellon Bank, pursuant to Section 61.32 (b) of the Commission's Rules.
