Application is hereby made by John Staurulakis, Inc. (JSI) for Special Permission for a limited waiver of Sections 61.58 and 61.59 of the Commission's rules. A grant of this application will allow JSI to file on behalf of Hargray Telephone Company (Hargray) to make changes in Switched Access-Direct Transport and Special Access rates that would have become effective on July 1, 2003 under Transmittal No. 84. Hargray files access rates pursuant to Section 61.38 of the Commission's rules. In addition to mandatory odd-numbered year filings for issuing carriers filing pursuant to Section 61.39 of the Commission's rules, Transmittal No. 84 included, *inter alia*, a mid-course adjustment filing for Hargray.

On June 23, 2003 AT&T Corp. (AT&T) filed a petition in which it, *inter alia*, requested that the Commission suspend for five months the rate revisions filed by JSI on behalf of Hargray in Transmittal No. 84 on June 16, 2003.¹ AT&T's request was based on its concerns regarding the increase in Account 6720 General and Administrative Expense reflected in the projected 2003/2004 annual interstate costs. JSI believes that AT&T's direct concerns regarding the increase in Account 6720 will be satisfactorily addressed by JSI's Reply on behalf of Hargray to AT&T's petition to be filed by JSI on June 27, 2003. However, during the course of reviewing the results of the projected 2003/2004 interstate revenue requirement, it came to the attention of JSI and Hargray that the Special Access Revenue requirement applicable to interexchange carriers was overstated due to understatement of the offset for Special Access revenue requirement that will be recovered from the billing of High Speed Internet Access (Hargray's xDSL access service).

A limited waiver of Section 61.59 of the Commission's rules will allow filing revisions to rates prior to having been in effect for 30 days in order to revise rates to reflect the reduction in the Special Access revenue requirement mentioned above. A waiver of Section 61.58 of the Commission's rules will allow the revised rates to become effective on less than 15 or, as the case may be, 7 days' notice.

If Special Permission is granted, the waivers will allow Hargray's revised Special Access and Switched Access-Local Transport rates for July 1, 2003 to reflect reduction of the projected annual Special Access revenue requirement by \$250,000 (eight percent). Switched Access-Local Transport rates are affected to the extent a particular Local Transport service may be based on the same facilities and technology of a corresponding Special Access service.


Attachment 1 to this Application for Special Permission summarizes the changes in revenue requirement and rates reflected in the proposed filing that JSI would make on behalf of Hargray in the event the Commission grants the Special Permission requested herein.

The proposed changes do not affect Hargray's revised Switched Access Local Switching rates as filed on June 16, 2003 in Transmittal No. 84.

JSI and Hargray recognize that the filing made under a transmittal filed under the authority of the Special Permission requested herein will be effective on less than 15 or, as the case may be, 7 days' notice and therefore will not be deemed lawful.
