The Verizon Telephone Companies (Verizon) hereby apply for Special Permission for a waiver of Sections 61.58 and 61.59 of the Commission's Rules in order to defer the effective date of tariff material filed under Transmittal No. 333.

On July 1, 2003, Verizon filed Transmittal No. 333, which introduced Verizon Infospeed Premium Digital Subscriber Line Service (Premium DSL). Following discussions with the Commission staff, Verizon is proposing to defer the effective date of material filed under Transmittal No. 333 from July 16, 2003 to July 23, 2003 to allow additional time for review.

A waiver of Section 61.58 is necessary in order to make changes to material on less than statutory notice. A waiver of Section 61.59 is necessary in order to make changes to pending tariff material.

This application and associated attachments are being filed electronically today via the Federal Communications Commission's Electronic Tariff Filing System (ETFS).
