This filing is being made on 15 days' notice under the Federal Communications Commission's streamlined filing procedure, and proposes the following revisions to Tariff F.C.C. No. 3:

- 1) Adjustment of special access voice grade and digital data service rates in the Orlando and Tallahassee, Florida; Fayetteville, Greenville, Hickory and Rocky Mount, North Carolina; Las Vegas, Nevada; York, Pennsylvania; and Charlottesville, Virginia MSAs where pricing flexibility has been granted in accordance with Subpart H of Part 69 of the Commission's rules.
- 2) Addition of tariff language which clarifies that the NetPointSM optional feature is designed for the transmission of data traffic.
- 3) Addition of tariff language identifying the DSL wire centers which comprise Virginia Region 2.

- 4) Revision of the Sprint Customer Access SolutionsSM (SCAS) tariff section to remove the wire center exchange names where SCAS is available, and add language stipulating that end offices equipped with frame relay facilities will be identified in the National Exchange Carrier Association Tariff F.C.C. No. 4.
- 5) Minor tariff language changes which clarify the provision of interstate access services.
