This filing is being made by Qwest in its Tariff F.C.C. No. 1, Section 8, Advanced Communications Networks, to implement a DMT *QWEST DSL Service Promotion*. Under the terms of this promotion, customers who subscribe to DMT *QWEST DSL PRO DELUXE*, DMT *QWEST DSL PRO 640 KBPS*, DMT *QWEST DSL PRO 1 MBPS*, DMT *QWEST DSL PRO 4 MBPS* and DMT *QWEST DSL PRO 7 MBPS* will receive a credit of \$100 after they have had service for 45 days. This promotion is scheduled to run from August 9, 2003 through September 26, 2003.

Qwest is implementing this promotion to stimulate demand for DSL Service. As a result of this promotion, Qwest estimates that demand for DSL services will increase as follows: 168 DMT *QWEST DSL PRO DELUXE*, 146 DMT *QWEST DSL PRO 640 KBPS*, 40 DMT *QWEST DSL PRO 1 MBPS*, 7 DMT *QWEST DSL PRO 4 MBPS* and 4 DMT *QWEST DSL PRO 7 MBPS*. Qwest expects a total increase in revenue of approximately \$259,318 for a twelve month period.

Supporting information discussed under Section 61.38 or 61.49 of the Commission's Rules is, to the extent required, included in this transmittal letter.
