Under this transmittal, Verizon is proposing the following:

- 1) Tariff revisions in its Tariff F.C.C. No. 14 for certain Switched Access Services and the addition of new Metropolitan Statistical Areas (MSAs) as allowed in the March 31, 2003 approval of Verizon's Petition for Pricing Flexibility (DA 03-1024).

Supporting material as specified under Section 61.49 of the Commission’s Rules is included with this filing. A document describing the services is also attached.

- 2) Verizon is including the Commonwealth of Virginia in its Verizon Five Cents Plan<sup>sm</sup> for its Tariff F.C.C. Nos. 4 and 15. This generic optional calling plan will provide residence customers in the Commonwealth of Virginia with a \$0.05 per minute rate on directly dialed regional toll calls
