With this filing CBT seeks revisions to recover its Universal Service Fund (USF) contribution pursuant to the Commission's Report And Order And Second Further Notice Of Proposed Rulemaking, FCC 02-329, Released December 13, 2002. CBT is making this filing in order to restructure its USF end user charge from a monthly computed flat rate charge to a percentage surcharge. CBT also proposes to make revisions in Section 8 -Billing Name and Address (BNA) Service to establish a minimum usage charge and to reduce to the initial start-up charge. Information regarding the proposed changes will be provided to affected customers.

The original letter, completed FCC Form 159, and a check for \$695.00 to pay the required filing fee were sent to Mellon Bank, Pittsburgh, PA via Federal Express on August 6, 2003.
