This filing is being made on 15 days' notice under the Federal Communications Commission's streamlined filing procedure, and proposes the following revisions to Tariff F.C.C. No. 3:

- 1) Addition of rates and regulations for the provision of switched dedicated and special access STS1 and OptiPoint-192 services and special access OC192 Sprint SONET Ring ServiceSM provided in the metropolitan statistical areas (MSAs) where pricing flexibility has been granted;

- 2) Addition of special construction charges for the installation of fiber optic facilities designed to meet the specific requirements of AT&T in the state of North Carolina;
- 3) Addition of rates and regulations for the provision of Contract Offerings associated with switched dedicated and/or special access services provided in the metropolitan statistical areas (MSAs) where pricing flexibility has been granted; and
- 4) Removal of an individual case basis filing in the state of Missouri that has been converted to general tariffed rates.
