The accompanying tariff materials issued by The Chillicothe Telephone Company, Inc. (Chillicothe) (**FRN #0005-0973-81**), and bearing FCC No. 1, effective September 1, 2003, are sent to you in compliance with the requirements of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended and pursuant to the Commission's Rules.

The purpose of this filing is to reduce the nonrecurring charge for all of the basic service packages for Chillicothe's Asymmetrical Digital Subscriber Line Access Service, and to reduce the monthly rates for the 384 Kbps, 768 Kbps and 1.5 Mbps packages.
