

THE CHILLICOTHE TELEPHONE COMPANY INTERSTATE ACCESS TARIFF REVISIONS

DESCRIPTION AND JUSTIFICATION

The Chillicothe Telephone Company (Chillicothe), submits the accompanying access tariff revisions to the Access Service Tariff FCC No. 1. Chillicothe is proposing to adjust Asymmetrical Digital Subscriber Line rates in Section 8.

Asymmetrical Digital Subscriber Line

Asymmetric Digital Subscriber Line (ADSL) Access Service enables data traffic generated by the customer's equipment to be transported to a DSL Access Service Connection Point using the customer's local exchange service facilities. The current basic service packages, per line, include service for 128 Kbps, 256 Kbps, 384 Kbps, 768 Kbps, and 1.5Mbps downstream speeds. The costs for the 384 Kbps, 768 Kbps, and the 1.5 Mbps have been ratcheted downward. The monthly rates are based on market sensitive pricing and reflect the current market conditions. The reduced nonrecurring charge is the same for all packages and cost support is provided in Exhibit 1.
