1.0 INTRODUCTION

With this filing, BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. (hereinafter "BellSouth") is revising the F.C.C. Tariff No. 1 to introduce two new price cap services: 1) a new service for BellSouth Managed Shared Frame Relay Service and Exchange Access Frame Relay Service, and 2) a new Minimum Qualifying Revenues schedule in the Fast Packet Savings Plan (FSP).

Transmittal No. 736 is scheduled to become effective on August 29, 2003.

2.0 NEW SERVICES

MultiLink Frame Relay

With this filing, BellSouth is adding a new capability to BellSouth Managed Shared Packet Services and BellSouth Exchange Access Services. This capability, MultiLink Frame Relay Service, will be offered to customers that subscribe to Managed Shared Frame Relay Service (MSFRS) and Exchange Access Frame Relay Service (XAFRS).

MultiLink Frame Relay service provides data customers with Frame Relay connections at speeds between DS1 to DS3 using the existing copper infrastructure in BellSouth's network and the Frame Relay Forum's FRF.16 standard.

Minimum Qualifying Revenues Schedule

With this filing, BellSouth is expanding its Fast Packet Savings Plan options by adding a new Entry Level Minimum Qualifying Revenues Schedule for the \$10,000,000 Minimum Monthly Revenue Commitment Level.

Revenues from these new services are included in the Trunking basket.
