With this transmittal, Verizon is submitting tariff pages and supporting data in compliance with the F.C.C.'s Order on application of the presubscribed interexchange carrier charge (PICC) to pay telephones¹, as well as reflecting the final Telecommunications Relay Service (TRS)² and Regulatory Fee³ exogenous costs.

Supporting data as required under Sections 61.41 through 61.49 of the Commission's Rules, and as further required by the above-referenced orders, is provided in two parts . Part A reflects the removal of demand for the Multi-Line Business PICC for pay telephone customers. Part B continues from the indices established in Part A and includes exogenous cost changes to reflect the new TRS and Regulatory Fee factors that have been released since the 2003 Annual Filing.

This transmittal letter and associated attachments are being filed electronically today via the Federal Communications Commission's Electronic Tariff Filing System (ETFS).

Payment in the amount of \$695.00 has been electronically transmitted to the Mellon Bank in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, in accordance with the fee program procedures. The Form 159 is being transmitted electronically over ETFS as a proprietary document.
