This filing is being made on 15 days' notice under the Commission's streamlined filing procedures, and adds rates and regulations implementing zone density pricing for switched transport and special access services provided in Sprint LTC's Indiana, Eastern (New Jersey and Pennsylvania) and Northwest (Oregon and Washington) jurisdictions. In addition, this filing adds special construction charges for the installation of fiber optic facilities designed to meet the specific requirements of customers in the states of Florida and Oregon.

It should be noted that, consistent with the requirements of Section 61.58(d)(4), affected customers will be notified of the proposed changes on or before the date of filing.
