This filing introduces DS3 Transmuxing as an optional feature for IntelliLight Dedicated SONET Ring (IDSR) service. The IDSR DS3 Trans mux port will perform a DS3 to DS1 conversion at an IDSR Enhanced Node. In addition, a 7-year term plan is introduced for IDSR ports in F.C.C. No. 1.

Support documentation as described in Part 61.49 of the Commission's rules is not required with this filing. However, a description of the services being filed is attached. Additionally, Figure 1 is attached for the new service options proposed for IDSR. Figure 1 will be used in the 2004 Annual Filing to demonstrate that these services options should be granted the same Phase I or Phase II regulatory relief in the MSAs and the Non-MSAs where the service category has been granted such relief.

This transmittal letter and associated attachments are being filed electronically today via the Federal Communications Commission's Electronic Tariff Filing System (ETFS).
