Application is hereby made by Nevada Bell Telephone Company (NBTC) for Special Permission to waive Sections 61.58 and 61.59 of the Commission's Rules in order to withdraw Transmittal No. 52 without becoming effective.

On October 9, 2003, NBTC issued Transmittal No. 52 which proposed the following modifications to the Gigabit Ethernet Metropolitan Area Network (GigaMAN[®]) Service. NBTC proposed to introduce Diversity options and a Repeater option, add GigaMAN[®] to NBTC's Expanded Interconnection Service in Section 18, and make miscellaneous text changes and additions to existing tariff language for clarification purposes. Transmittal No. 52 is scheduled to become effective on October 24, 2003.

With this application, NBTC requests permission to waive Sections 61.58 and 61.59 of the Commission's Rules in order to withdraw tariff material originally filed under Transmittal No. 52 without becoming effective. NBTC wishes to withdraw Transmittal 52 without becoming effective because NBTC inadvertently made the filing without the benefit of cost material to support the Expanded Interconnection Service part of the filing.

A waiver of Section 61.58 is requested to permit the revision of tariff material to become effective on not less than 1 day's notice. A waiver of Section 61.59 is requested to permit revisions to tariff material that has not been in effect for thirty (30) days.

This Application letter and the appropriate illustrative tariff pages are being filed electronically today via the Federal Communications Commission's Electronic Tariff Filing System (ETFS).

Payment in the amount of \$695.00 has been electronically transmitted to the Mellon Bank in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, in accordance with the fee program procedures. The Form 159 is being transmitted electronically via ETFS as a proprietary document. These actions have been committed on the date established as the issued (filed) date as reflected above.
