On October 9, 2003, NBTC issued Transmittal No. 52 which proposed the following modifications to the Gigabit Ethernet Metropolitan Area Network (GigaMAN[®]) Service. NBTC proposed to introduce Diversity options and a Repeater option, add GigaMAN[®] to NBTC's Expanded Interconnection Service in Section 18, and make miscellaneous text changes and additions to existing tariff language for clarification purposes. Transmittal No. 52 is scheduled to become effective on October 24, 2003.

With this filing, NBTC is withdrawing material originally filed under Transmittal No. 52 without becoming effective and restoring currently effective material. NBTC is withdrawing Transmittal 52 because NBTC inadvertently made the filing without the benefit of cost material to support the Expanded Interconnection Service part of the filing.
