With this transmittal, Verizon makes revisions to its Asynchronous Transfer Mode Cell Relay Service (ATM Cell Relay Service) provided to customers in the State of New Jersey. ATM Cell Relay Service is a telecommunications transport and switching service that provides for high-speed connectivity between customer-designated locations. A detailed Description of these revisions is provided as an attachment to this filing. These tariff revisions are being made as part of a phased approach to realign Verizon's ATM Cell Relay Service offering across the entire Verizon footprint.

Supporting material as described under Sections 61.49 of Commission's Rules is provided with this filing. In addition, Figure 1 identifies certain Port with Access Line Connection and Port Only Connection rate elements being introduced in this filing as a new Price Cap service for

Tariff F.C.C. No. 1.
