28. Expanded Interconnection# (Cont'd) (C)

28.1 Fiber Optic Expanded Interconnection - General

The regulations set forth in this Section 28.1 apply to the following: (N)

- (1) Virtual Expanded Interconnection arrangements
- (2) Fiber Optic Expanded Interconnection arrangements which are in-service or on order (i.e., an Expanded Interconnection application has been submitted to the Telephone Company) prior to (tariff effective date) and have not converted under 28.1.1(H) following.

Except as set forth above, physical collocation is available pursuant to the Order in WC Docket No. 02-237, adopted October 17, 2003 and released October 22, 2003. (N) (x)

Interconnections are available on a first-come first-served basis subject to the availability of space and facilities in each serving wire center, access tandem or remote node on a negotiated interval. Specific designations for Physical, Virtual and SCOPE arrangements are shown on the Collocation Space Summary, which can be found on the Telephone Company's Internet website at http://www.bellatlantic.com/wholesale/html/res_site_summ.htm. The minimum period for which Fiber Optic Expanded Interconnection is provided is three months.
