This filing, issued under authority of Special Permission No. 03-110, makes tariff revisions to withdraw material filed under Transmittal No. 386 and to reinstate material presently in effect. On December 2, 2003, Verizon filed Transmittal No. 386, which made revisions to Frame Relay Service to introduce Metro Fractional User to Network Interface (UNI) Port With Access Line Connections. After discussions with the Commission staff, Verizon has decided to withdraw the tariff for further internal review.

Supporting information as required by 61.49 of the Commission's Rules is not required with this filing.
