The accompanying tariff material, issued on behalf of the Sprint local telephone companies (Sprint LTC) and bearing Tariff F.C.C. Nos. 2 and 3, is sent to you for filing in compliance with the requirements of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended.

The revisions contained in this filing are scheduled to become effective as indicated herein, and consist of tariff pages as set forth on the following check sheets:

The revisions to Tariff F.C.C. No. 3 are being filed on 15 days' notice under the Commission's streamlined filing procedures and are scheduled to become effective January 3, 2004. These revisions:

- (1) Add rates offering Asynchronous Transfer Mode access terminations, interoffice mileage, user-to-network and network-to-network port connections, and permanent virtual circuits at speeds lower than 155.52 Mbps (OC3) to customers in the state of Nevada and adjust rates at the 155.52 Mbps level.
- (2) Add recurring rates and nonrecurring charges for the special construction of fiber optic facilities designed to satisfy the specific requirements of certain customers in the states of Missouri, North Carolina and Texas.

The revisions to Tariff F.C.C. No. 2 are being filed on one day's notice in compliance with Section 61.58(d)(2) of the Commission's Rules, and are scheduled to become effective December 20, 2003. These revisions add rates and regulations introducing 30-Mile Unlimited Interstate as an optional calling plan available to individual residential and business customers.

Cost support material in accordance with Sections 61.38 and 61.41 through 61.49 of the Commission's Rules is provided, where required, for this filing.

In accordance with the requirements of Section 61.21(a)(3) of the Commission's Rules, the FCC Registration Number (FRN) for Sprint is 0003-7619-39. Sprint LTC is filing this transmittal on behalf of issuing carriers with the following FRNs:
