Application is hereby made by BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc, (hereinafter BellSouth), for Special Permission to waive Sections 61.58 and 61.59 of the Commission's Rules in order to revise material filed under Transmittal No. 775.

On January 2, 2004, under Transmittal No. 775, BellSouth revised Tariff F.C.C. No. 1 to introduce a special nonrecurring charge promotion for its Fast Packet Access Services.

With this application, BellSouth proposes to correct the effective dates of the promotional period. The correct dates are January 17, 2004 through April 16, 2004, as stated in the Description and Justification provided with Transmittal No. 775 instead of January 6, 2004 through April 5, 2004 as stated on the tariff pages.
