Interstate IntraLATA Customer Dialed Calling Card Station calls made by dialing a Special Access Number (e.g., 800/888 number) will now be charged pursuant to NBTC Tariff F.C.C. 2. Previously customers were charged pursuant to Sprint rates and charges.
