This filing is issued to change the way the fixed portion of Verizon Optical Networking (VON) Channel Mileage is applied in FCC No. 14 and FCC No. 16; rather than apply the fixed portion once per circuit, the fixed portion will be applied at each servicing wire center. This application of the rate is similar to the way the Company has traditionally applied the Special Transport Terminations for Special Access DS1s and DS3s. This filing is also making some administrative changes in FCC No. 14.

In addition, this filing is deleting an issuing carrier in FCC No. 15, as an administrative change, and is deleting a connecting carrier in FCC No. 18, at the request of Pacific Bell Telephone.

Payment in the amount of \$695.00 has been electronically transmitted to the Mellon Bank in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, in accordance with the fee program procedures. The Form 159 is being transmitted electronically via ETFS as a proprietary document.
