Transmittal No. 2 of the TXU Communications Companies

The accompanying tariff material, issued by the TXU Communications Companies (TXUCC; FRN #0010-1553-98), consisting of TXU Communications Telephone Company (TXUCTC) and Ft. Bend Telephone Company (FBTC), and bearing Tariff F.C.C. No. 1, Access Service, is sent to you for filing in compliance with the requirements of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended. The proposed effective date of February 24, 2004, is fifteen days after the filing date, in accordance with Section 204(a)(3) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended.

This tariff filing modifies ADSL service provided by FBTC to become identical with ADSL service provided by TXUCTC. This required minor rate decreases and no rate increases to bring the 2 companies to identical services. Further details are found in the Description and Justification submitted with this transmittal.

In order to create an incentive to increase the penetration, the TXU Communications Companies are also proposing to institute a promotion in which the first month's recurring charges are waived when the customer signs up for a one-year Term Payment Plan (TPP). Overall, these changes will be an advantage to the Companies' customers, expand the penetration of ADSL service, and greatly simplify the administration of the service for the Companies.
