The first part of this filing is being made by Qwest in its Tariff F.C.C. No. 1, Section 8, Advanced Communications Networks to offer a promotion for ATM, Local Area Network (LAN) Switching Service (LSS) and Frame Relay Service (FRS). Under the terms of this promotion, Qwest will waive the nonrecurring charges for customers who purchase ATM, FRS and LSS with term plans of 36-months or greater. This promotion will be in effect from March 1, 2004 through May 28, 2004.

Qwest is offering this promotion to stimulate demand. As a result of this promotion Qwest estimates that demand for these Services will increase as follows: 24 ATM Services, 1,254 Frame Relay Services and 3 LSS Services. Qwest expects a total increase in revenue of approximately \$4,986,000 for the first twelve months.

Supporting information discussed under Sections 61.38 and 61.49 of the Commission's Rules is, to the extent required, included in this transmittal letter.

Qwest is also implementing a change to *QWEST DSL* Service and introducing a DSL promotion. Supporting information discussed under Sections 61.38 and 61.49 of the Commission's Rules is included in the attached Description and Justification (D&J).

As part of this filing Qwest is also implementing changes associated with Pricing Flexibility in its Tariff F.C.C. No. 1 Section 17. Qwest is modifying rates on selected interstate Private Line services located in the Interstate Pricing Flexibility Phase II Wire Centers as defined in Section 23 of Qwest's Interstate Tariff (FCC No. 1). The rate changes are effective for Low Speed Data, Analog Private Line Services, Digital Data Private Line Services, SONET Ring Service and DS3 Private Line Service.

Section 69.727 eliminates the need to file supporting information discussed under price cap regulation.
