Application is hereby made by Illinois Consolidated Telephone Company (ICTC) for Special Permission to waive Sections 61.58 and 61.59 of the Commission's Rules to withdraw without becoming effective Transmittal No. 120 issued by ICTC and bearing F.C.C. No. 2. Application is further made for Special Permission to waive Section 61.74 of the Commission's Rules in order for ICTC to cross reference ICTC's website.

On February 24, 2004, ICTC filed Transmittal No. 120, to incorporate new special access high capacity term discount rates and language; revise and incorporate general regulations language for Payment of Rates, Charges and Deposits; incorporate new language for ordering options for switched access and special access; revise channel mileage termination language; increase rates for basic and overtime labor; revise and incorporate new jurisdictional verification language; introduce Symmetric Digital Subscriber Line Access Service language and rates; and create an offering for wholesale digital subscriber line rates. The revisions were scheduled to become effective March 10, 2004.

With this application, ICTC requests permission to waive Sections 61.58 and 61.59 of the Commission's Rules in order to restore current effective material and withdraw tariff material filed under Transmittal No. 120. ICTC wishes to withdraw Transmittal No. 120 without becoming effective in order to review issues identified by the Commission Staff. A waiver of Section 61.58 is requested to permit the revised tariff material to become effective on less than one day's notice. A waiver of Section 61.59 is requested to permit revisions to tariff material that has not yet become effective and to reinstate currently effective tariff rates and regulations.

After reviewing the issues identified by Commission Staff, ICTC plans to refile the proposed tariff revisions. With this application, ICTC further requests permission to waive Section 61.74 of the Commission's Rules because in the refiled tariff revisions, it would like to make a cross reference to ICTC's website where end users can determine if end user lines are DSL capable.
