With this filing, issued under authority of Special Permission No. 04-023, Verizon is hereby submitting tariff pages to introduce Internet Protocol – Virtual Private Network (IP-VPN) Service. A detailed explanation of IP-VPN Service is provided in a Description as an attachment to this filing.

IP-VPN Service is an interstate special access service utilizing category 1.2 facilities, as defined in Section 36.154, and is not a "loop-based" service per the definition in paragraph 61.3(yy) of the Commission's rules. Therefore, pursuant to paragraph 61.49(f)(3), this filing is being made without cost support. In addition, Figure 1 identifies IP-VPN Service as a new Price Cap service for Tariff F.C.C. No. 1. Pursuant to Paragraph 173 of the Commission's decision on pricing flexibility (FCC 99-206 Fifth Report and Order and Further Notice of Proposed Rulemaking, released August 27, 1999), Figure 1 demonstrates the basket and service category into which this service will be properly incorporated in the next Annual Filing in 2005.

Payment in the amount of \$695.00 has been electronically transmitted to the Mellon Bank in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, in accordance with the fee program procedures. The Form 159 is being transmitted electronically via ETFS as a proprietary document. -
