RE: April 30th Shortform TRP Letter Filing

The Verizon Telephone Companies¹ will be filing their 2004 Annual Price Cap Filing in compliance with Section 61.43 of the Commission's rules. As required by Section 61.49(k), attached is an advance submission of Verizon's 2004 Tariff Review Plan (TRP) for the purpose of early review and submitted in the format prescribed in the 2004 Tariff Review Plan Order.²

This filing provides the necessary inputs and documentation to calculate the new Price Cap Indices. The new Price Cap Indices reflect the use of 2003 base period demand, changes in exogenous costs and, where appropriate, the GDP Price Index (GDP-PI) and X factor. All support documentation is attached to this Letter.

This letter and associated attachments are being filed electronically today via the Federal Communications Commission's Electronic Tariff Filing System.
