The Verizon Telephone Companies (Verizon) hereby apply for Special Permission for a waiver of Section 61.74 of the Commission's Rules.

Verizon intends to introduce National Transparent LAN Service (National TLS) in its Tariff FCC No. 20, Communications Services and Tariff FCC No. 1, Access Services. National TLS provides the ability to interconnect ethernet Transparent LAN Service in one LATA with an Interexchange Carrier or other Service Provider, allowing customer data to be transported to ethernet Transparent LAN Service in another LATA. Verizon is making reference in both tariffs to The Local Exchange Routing Guide (LERG), published by Telcordia, should customers require further information to determine which LATA they are located in order to verify availability of service.

Verizon requests special permission to waive the requirements of Section 61.74 in order to make reference to Local Exchange Routing Guide for the prior-mentioned reason.

Illustrative tariff pages are included with this application. This application and associated attachments are being filed electronically today via the Federal Communications Commission's Electronic Tariff Filing System (ETFS).
