This filing, issued under authority of Special Permission No. 04-034 of the Federal Communications Commission, introduces National Transparent LAN Service as a new option for Transparent LAN Service customers. A detailed Description of the revisions is provided as an attachment to this filing.

Transparent LAN Service is an interstate special access service utilizing category 1.2 facilities, as defined in Section 36.154, and is not a "loop-based" service per the definition in paragraph 61.3(yy) of the Commission's rules). Therefore, pursuant to paragraph 61.49(f)(3), the new services associated with this filing are being filed without cost support. In addition, Figure 1 identifies National TLS as a new Price Cap service for Tariff F.C.C. No. 1. Pursuant to Paragraph 173 of the Commission's decision on pricing flexibility (FCC 99-206 Fifth Report and Order and Further Notice of Proposed Rulemaking, released August 27, 1999), Figure 1 demonstrates the basket and service category into which this service will be properly incorporated in the next Annual Filing.

Payment in the amount of \$695.00 has been electronically transmitted to the Mellon Bank in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, in accordance with the fee program procedures. The Form 159 is being transmitted electronically via ETFS.
