The Verizon Telephone Companies (Verizon) hereby apply for Special Permission for a waiver of Section 61.74 of the Commission's Rules.

Verizon is planning to introduce a new contract tariff option in its Tariff F.C.C. Nos. 1, 11, and 14. Each tariff must reference the regulations, rates, and charges for certain Special Access services included in the other tariffs in order to describe the eligibility requirements for the contract.

Verizon therefore requests special permission to waive the requirements of Section 61.74 of the Commission's Rules in order to make the appropriate tariff references.

Illustrative tariff pages are included with this application.
