The Verizon Telephone Companies (Verizon) hereby apply for Special Permission for a waiver of Section 61.58 and 61.59 of the Commission's Rules.

On May 10, 2004, Verizon filed Transmittal No. 438, which introduced National Transparent LAN Service in its Tariff FCC No 1, Access Service, and Tariff FCC No. 20, Communications Services. Transmittal No. 438 is scheduled to become effective May 25, 2004. Based on discussions with the Commission staff, Verizon wishes to withdraw the tariff material filed under Transmittal No. 438 and reinstate material presently in effect.

A waiver of Section 61.59 is necessary in order to make changes to material not yet in effect and a waiver of Section 61.58 is necessary to file on less than statutory notice.

This application and associated attachments are being filed electronically today via the Federal Communications Commission's Electronic Tariff Filing System (ETFS).
