- 1) With this filing, Verizon wishes to introduce Inverse Multiplexing ATM (IMA), an enhancement to local ATM Cell Relay service. A full description of the offered service is provided as a Description attachment with this filing.

Support material as specified under Section 61.49 of the Commission's Rules is not required with this filing. In addition, Figure 1 is attached which will be used in the 2005 Annual Filing to demonstrate that this service should be granted the same Phase I or Phase II regulatory relief in the MSAs and the Non-MSAs where the service category has been granted such relief.

- 2) This filing is being made to establish Telecommunications Relay Service (TRS) Equal Access Interconnection in Tariff FCC No. 14. This service will enable TRS providers to offer their end users Carrier of Choice through a direct connection from a TRS Carrier to a Verizon Telephone Company access tandem.
