The accompanying tariff material, issued by the Verizon Telephone Companies (Verizon) and bearing Tariff FCC No 1, Access Service and Tariff FCC No. 11, Access Service, is sent to you for filing in compliance with the requirements of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended. On May 13, 2004, Verizon filed Transmittal No. 441 to introduce Contract Tariff Option 11 in Tariff No. 1 and Option 14 in Tariff No. 11 which would provide reduced rates and charges for new installation of IntelliLight Optical Transport Service (IOTS), subject to a customer meeting the eligibility requirements set forth in the specific contract tariff options.

On May 18, 2004, Verizon filed Transmittal No. 443 to introduce Contract Tariff Option 12 in Tariff No. 1 and Option 15 in Tariff No. 11 which would provide reduced rates and charges for new installation of IntelliLight Dedicated SONET Ring (IDSR), subject to a customer meeting the eligibility requirements set forth in the specific contract tariff options.

Based on discussions with the Commission Staff and under authority of Special Permission No. 04-044 of the Federal Communications Commission, Verizon is withdrawing the proposed revisions for these contract tariff options and reinstating material presently in effect.

Supporting information is not required with this filing.
