The Verizon Telephone Companies include Verizon Delaware Inc.; Verizon Maryland Inc.; Verizon New England Inc.; Verizon New Jersey Inc.; Verizon New York Inc.; Verizon Pennsylvania Inc.; Verizon Virginia Inc.; Verizon Washington, D.C. Inc.; and Verizon West Virginia Inc. These companies will now be referred to as Verizon-East. Verizon East is comprised of the former Bell Atlantic-North (NYNEX) and Bell Atlantic-South. The Verizon Telephone Companies also include the states of AZ, CA, FL, HI, ID, IL, IN, MI, NC, NV, OH, OR, PA, SC, TX, VA, WA, WI, and Micronesia. These jurisdictions will be referred to as Verizon-West (formerly GTOC and GSTC). This transmittal only covers the former Bell Atlantic South.

With this transmittal, Verizon is filing their 2004 Annual Price Cap Filing in compliance with Section 61.43 of the Commission's rules. As required by Section 61.49(k), attached is Verizon's 2004 Tariff Review Plan (TRP) in accordance with the 2004 Tariff Review Plan Order.² This filing provides the necessary inputs and documentation to calculate the new Price Cap Indices. The new Price Cap Indices reflect the use of 2003 base period demand, changes in exogenous costs and, where appropriate, the GDP Price Index (GDP-PI) and X factor.

Support information as specified in Section 61.49 of the Commission's Rules is included with this filing. Some of this information is filed with a request that it be treated as confidential under the Freedom of Information Act. A letter requesting that it be placed under the Protective Order designated in the Tariff Streamlining Order is attached.

This transmittal letter and associated attachments are being filed electronically today via the Federal Communications Commission's Electronic Tariff Filing System (ETFS).
