In addition to 2004 annual filings for the carriers filing under Section 61.38, this filing includes proposed revisions in charges for the Federal Universal Service Contribution (FUSC) reflective of the increase in the Universal Service Contribution Factor from 8.7% to 8.9% for the third quarter of 2004.
