With this filing, Verizon is removing the tariff references for Digital Subscriber Line (DSL) service that limit the availability of the service to lines over which line sharing is available. Verizon's obligation to provide line sharing was eliminated in the Federal Communications Commission's Triennial Review Order (TRO). That portion of the TRO was also upheld by the

DC Circuit Court's mandate dated June 16, 2004. Also, with this filing, Verizon is changing references to "facilities" rather than "copper facilities" in its DSL regulations. Accordingly, the tariff will now state that DSL service will be provisioned over available facilities over which Company provides local telephone exchange service pursuant to its general and/or local exchange tariffs.

Supporting material as specified under Sections 61.49 of the Commissions Rules is not required with this filing.

Payment in the amount of \$695.00 has been electronically transmitted to the Mellon Bank in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, in accordance with the fee program procedures. The Form 159 is being transmitted electronically via ETFS.
