1. Application of Tariff

1.1 This tariff contains rates and charges applicable to the provision of Switched Access and Special Access Services, and other miscellaneous services, hereinafter referred to collectively as service, provided by the Geneseo Telephone Company, hereinafter referred to as the Telephone Company, to customers. Refusal and discontinuance of service to interstate customers for non-payment of Universal Service Fund charges shall be in accordance with National Exchange Carrier Association Tariff No. 5, Section 2.

1.2 The provision of such service by the Telephone Company as set forth in this tariff does not constitute a joint undertaking with the Customer for the furnishing of any service.
