The accompanying tariff material, issued by the Verizon Telephone Companies (Verizon) and bearing Tariff F.C.C. No. 1, Access Service, and Tariff F.C.C. With this transmittal, Verizon is submitting tariff pages to introduce new User Network Interface Port Only Connections for 128 Kbps, 256 Kbps, 384 Kbps (where not currently tariffed), 512 Kbps and 768 Kbps speeds for Frame Relay Service customers who order service from Part I, Sections 5.1 and 5.8 of Tariff F.C.C. No. 20 and Section 16.3 of Tariff F.C.C. No. 1. These new Port Only Connections will be available on a Month-to-Month basis or under One Year, Three Year or Five Year Term Payment Plans. Frame Relay Service is a medium to high speed connection-oriented packet switched data service that allows for the interconnection of Local Area Networks or other compatible customer equipment across a wide area for the purpose of interstate access.

Frame Relay Service is an interstate special access service utilizing category 1.2 facilities, as defined in Section 36.154, and is not a "loop-based" service per the definition in paragraph 61.3(yy) of the Commission's rules). Therefore, pursuant to paragraph 61.49(f)(3), the new services associated with this filing are being filed without cost support. In addition, Figure 1 identifies Frame Relay Service as a new Price Cap service for Tariff F.C.C. No. 1. Pursuant to Paragraph 173 of the Commission's decision on pricing flexibility (FCC 99-206 Fifth Report and Order and Further Notice of Proposed Rulemaking, released August 27, 1999), Figure 1 demonstrates the basket and service category into which this service will be properly incorporated in the next Annual Filing.

Payment in the amount of \$720.00 has been electronically transmitted to the Mellon Bank in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, in accordance with the fee program procedures. The Form 159 is being transmitted electronically via ETFS.

In accordance with the requirements of Section 61.21(a)(3) of the Commission's Rules, the F.C.C. Registration Number (FRN) for Verizon is 0003-7085-00. Verizon is filing this transmittal on behalf of issuing carriers with the following FRNs:
