The accompanying tariff material, issued on behalf of Qwest Corporation (Qwest) FRN 0003-7467-57 (Concurring Carriers, The Malheur Home Telephone Company FRN 0003-7467-65 and El Paso County Telephone Company FRN 0004-3212-46), and bearing Tariff F.C.C. No. 1, effective as reflected on the attached tariff pages, is sent to you in compliance with the requirements of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended.

Qwest is filing tariff language in its Tariff F.C.C. No. 1, Section 8, Advanced Communications Networks, to extend its promotion for *Qwest Choice DSL*, *Qwest Choice DSL Deluxe* and Stand Alone *Qwest DSL*. Under the terms of this promotion, the Nonrecurring Charge for these services is reduced to \$9.99. In addition, the Monthly Recurring Charge for *Qwest Choice DSL Deluxe* is reduced to \$26.99 for the first three months of service. This promotion is now scheduled to run through January 8, 2004.

Qwest is extending this promotion to stimulate demand for its DSL Products. As a result of this extension, Qwest estimates that demand for DSL services will increase as follows: 1,448 *Qwest Choice DSL*, 1,361 *Qwest Choice DSL Deluxe* and 87 Stand Alone *Qwest DSL*. Qwest expects a total increase in revenue of approximately \$494,798 annualized.

As part of this filing Qwest is also adding language to its tariff that would allow it to contact *Qwest DSL Service* subscribers in the event a *QWEST DSL HOST* customer is being terminated or is exiting the business. This will allow the affected *Qwest DSL Service* subscriber to determine a replacement *QWEST DSL HOST* without incurring interrupted service.

Qwest is also deleting some tariff language under DSL Regulations that is almost identical to language contained under DSL pricing plans where it is more appropriate.

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Supporting information discussed under Sections 61.38 and 61.49 of the Commission's Rules is, to the extent required, included in this transmittal letter.

The Tariff filing fee in the amount of \$720.00 is being paid by credit card through the appropriate entries in Section E of the ETFS generated Form 159.
