On October 8, 2004, the Verizon Telephone Companies (Verizon) issued Transmittal No. 500 to make rate level changes to its Verizon Digital Subscriber Line (DSL) service offerings in Tariff F.C.C. Nos. 1 and 20.

Verizon is filing this amendment in order to correct an error in the paragraph referencing what supporting information was included with the filing. The first sentence stated that Verizon DSL is not a “loop-based” service. With this amendment, Verizon is deleting that inaccurate sentence. The supporting information paragraph will now read as follows:

Supporting information required by Section 61.49 of the Commission’s Rules is included for the Installation Nonrecurring Charge reduction proposed in Tariff F.C.C. No. 1. All other rate level changes in both Tariff F.C.C. No. 1 and Tariff F.C.C. No. 20 are submitted without API and SBI supporting data, pursuant to paragraph 61.49(f)(3), because they have not yet been incorporated under the applicable price cap indexes.

In accordance with the requirements of Section 61.21(a)(3) of the Commission's Rules, the F.C.C. Registration Number (FRN) for Verizon is 0003-7085-00. Verizon is filing this amended transmittal on behalf of issuing carriers with the following FRNs:
