This filing is being made on 15 days' notice under the Commission's streamlined filing procedures and includes the following revisions to Tariff F.C.C. No. 3:

- (1) Revisions to Sprint LTC's term discount plan and premier term discount plan to extend the customer renewal period from 90 days to 12 months (365 days);
- (2) Addition of rates offering Asynchronous Transfer Mode access terminations, interoffice mileage, user-to-network and network-to-network port connections, and permanent virtual circuits at 622.08 Mbps (OC12), while reducing various rates for existing 155.52 Mbps (OC3) ATM service in the states of Nevada and North Carolina; and
- (3) Addition of special construction charges for the installation of fiber optic and copper facilities designed to meet the specific requirements of customers in the states of Missouri, Nevada, Ohio and Oregon.

In addition, Sprint LTC proposes to adjust its pay telephone surcharge rate in its interstate/intraLATA MTS Tariff F.C.C. No. 2. This revision is made as a result of the FCC's Report and Order, *In the Matter of Request to Update Default Compensation Rate for Dial-Around Calls from Payphones*, FCC 04-182 (WC Docket No. 03-225), released August 12, 2004.


Cost support material in accordance with Sections 61.38 and 61.41 through 61.49 of the Commission's Rules is provided, where required, for this filing.
