**Re: Application for Special Permission**

Dear Ms. Dortch:

The Chillicothe Telephone Company ("Chillicothe") hereby requests Special Permission to withdraw Transmittal No. 83 (filed November 3, 2004) to its Tariff F.C.C. No. 1 before it becomes effective on November 18, 2004 and to reinstate its currently effective tariff materials.

Transmittal No. 83 was comprised of tariff materials that were issued inadvertently before they were finalized and approved by Chillicothe.

Waivers of Sections 61.58 and 61.59 of the Commission's Rules are needed in order for Chillicothe to withdraw the rates and regulations in Transmittal No. 83 (which rates and regulations have not yet become effective) on one day's notice, and to reinstate its current effective rates and regulations.

Copies of the proposed revised tariff pages are attached.

Pursuant to Section 61.32(b) of the Rules, the original of this Application For Special Permission, FCC Form 159, and the Commission's filing fee of seven hundred twenty dollars (\$720.00) are being filed this date with the Mellon Bank in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania.
