Under authority of Special Permission No. 04-078 of the Federal Communications Commission, Verizon is submitting tariff pages that introduce a new Contract Tariff Option ("option") in its Tariff F.C.C. Nos. 1, 11, and 14. The new option is being filed in those Access Service tariffs where Verizon has received Pricing Flexibility relief for Special Access Services in qualifying Metropolitan Statistical Areas ("MSAs"). The new option is introduced as Contract Tariff Option 18 in Tariff FCC No. 1, Contract Tariff Option 20 in Tariff FCC No. 11 and Contract Tariff Option 10 in Tariff FCC No. 14. This option provides a customer with a one-time billing credit when the customer achieves certain amounts of total billed revenue for qualifying services during the service period of the option.
