With this transmittal, Verizon is submitting tariff pages in order to revise the terms and conditions pertaining to its Billing Name and Address (BNA) Miscellaneous Service in its Tariff F.C.C. Nos. 1 and 11. In Verizon’s Tariff F.C.C. No. 11, Verizon is clarifying its existing rate regulations to indicate that the BNA charge will apply “per request processed” rather than “per message processed.” In Verizon’s Tariff F.C.C. No. 1, the customer will now be charged for each record that either is not found in Verizon’s data base, or is not able to be provided due to the fact that the telephone number is unlisted or non-published (i.e., for each BNA request processed) in addition to being charged for each record found.

Support material as specified under Section 61.49 of the Commissions Rules is not required with this filing. However, a document describing these revisions is attached.

Payment in the amount of \$720.00 has been electronically transmitted to the Mellon Bank in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, in accordance with the fee program procedures. The Form 159 is being transmitted electronically via ETFS.
