4. End User Access Service (Cont'd)4.6 Rate Regulations (Cont'd)

- (R) WLNP End User Access Service provides local exchange service customers the ability to (1) retain the same telephone number when changing from one wireless service provider to another or between wireline and wireless service providers and (2) complete calls to ported telephone numbers.

Pursuant to the requirements of CC Docket No. 95-116, In the Matter of Telephone Number Portability, BellSouth Corporation Petition for Declaratory Ruling and/or Waiver, released April 13, 2004, the WLNP end user charge is designed to recover certain costs incurred by the Telephone Company for the provision of WLNP. The WLNP end user charge, as set forth in 4.7(D) following, will be billed on a per network access line, per individual derived voice channel, per resold line, or per switching port basis for a period of six months beginning on July 16, 2004 and ending January 15, 2005, with the following exceptions:

- Application of the WLNP end user charge is limited to customers served by Telephone Company end offices capable of providing local number portability.
- The WLNP end user charge is applicable to resellers of the Telephone Company's local exchange services, and to purchasers of its switching ports as unbundled network elements under Section 251 of the Telecommunications Act.
- End users who qualify for a reduced residential local exchange rate as set forth in (K) preceding will not be assessed the WLNP end user charge.
- When an end user is provided an Integrated Services Digital Network/ Primary Rate Interface (ISDN/PRI) or Enhanced Service Provider (ESP) link arrangement, the WLNP end user charge will be multiplied by five and applies for each such arrangement.
- When an end user is provided Private Branch Exchange (PBX) service under the general and/or local exchange tariffs of the Telephone Company, the WLNP end user charge will be multiplied by nine and applies for each such PBX arrangement.
