## **DESCRIPTION AND JUSTIFICATION**

### **BELLSOUTH FAST PACKET ACCESS SERVICES**

#### **1.0 INTRODUCTION**

With this filing, BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. (hereinafter "BellSouth") is revising the Tariff F.C.C. No. 1, Section 21, to introduce Customer Configuration Management Capability as a new optional service feature for BellSouth Managed Shared Frame Relay Service (MSFRS) and Exchange Access Frame Relay Service (XAFRS).

Transmittal No. 865 is being filed on December 15, 2004 and is scheduled to become effective on December 16, 2004.

#### **2.0 NEW SERVICE**

BellSouth is adding Customer Configuration Management Capability as a new optional service feature for MSFRS and XAFRS; this new capability will allow the customer to add, change and delete permanent virtual circuits (PVCs) themselves without utilizing the standard ordering and provisioning process to request BellSouth to perform these functions. The customer shall subscribe to a desired quantity of Configurable DLCI Bundles for each MSFRS Connection and XAFRS Network Interface with Network Visibility Service (NVS). The customer will then have access thru the NVS system to mechanically add, change and delete configurable PVCs between such Frame Relay ports by mapping the Configurable DLCIs together. The Configurable DLCI Bundle charges billed for such ports are applicable for the configurable PVCs in lieu of the standard individual DLCI, CIR and ISAL Charges in the Frame Relay tariffs for standard PVCs established by BellSouth.

Revenues from this new service are included in the Trunking basket.
