The Verizon Telephone Companies (Verizon) hereby apply for Special Permission for a waiver of Section 61.74 of the Commission's Rules.

Verizon is planning to introduce a new IntelliLight® Entrance Facility (IEF) Contract Tariff Option in its Tariff F.C.C. Nos. 1 and 11. These Contract Tariff Options are offered exclusively to customers who meet certain minimum IEF system and associated STS-1 termination requirements as described in these options. The minimum IEF System requirement is comprised of new IEF systems, IEF systems that are converted from certain other contract tariff options (as described in the proposed revisions), or a combination of both. Each tariff must reference the other tariff for the purpose of determining eligibility and for the listing of Metropolitan Services Areas (MSAs) where these contract tariff options are offered.

Verizon therefore requests special permission to waive the requirements of Section 61.74 of the Commission's Rules in order to make the appropriate tariff references for the above-mentioned reasons.

Illustrative tariff pages are included with this application.

This application and associated attachments are being filed electronically today via the Federal Communications Commission's Electronic Tariff Filing System (ETFS).
