On December 10, 2004, NBTC issued Transmittal No. 82, wherein it proposed modifications to Additional Engineering, Additional Labor, and Miscellaneous Services found in NBTC's Tariff F.C.C. No. 1. NBTC sought to (1) modify the definition for business day; (2) standardize basic time, overtime and premium time; (3) introduce applications and regulations to the existing additional labor and maintenance of service regulations; (4) modify the duration of standby; and (4) make miscellaneous text changes and additions to existing tariff language for clarification purposes. Rate changes were incorporated to account for offset due to revisions made in this tariff filing. Transmittal No. 82 is scheduled to become effective on December 25, 2004.

With this filing, NBTC is restoring currently effective material and withdrawing tariff material originally filed under Transmittal No. 82 without becoming effective. NBTC wishes to withdraw Transmittal No. 82 without becoming effective in order to review issues identified in the proposed modifications.

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
